

The Newton Fund is part of the UK's official development assistance(ODA). Its aim is to develop science and innovation partnerships that promote the economic development and welfare of emerging countries.












Newton Fund in Brazil



The Chancellor of Exchequer, Rt Hon George Osborne launched in April 2014 Newton Fund in Brazil.

It is a three years partnership and the UK is committing £ 9 million per year.

People – Fellowships for Brazilian Researchers



1. Newton Advanced Fellowships(RS,BA, AMS):

- Salary top up for the Brazilian applicant, research support, travel and subsistence, training
- Awards up to two years, up to 37K each year
- Natural sciences including engineering, clinical or patient-oriented research, social sciences and humanities
- Early to mid-career researchers based in Brazil no more than 15 years post PhD
- Closing date of applications: 22nd October 2014

- 2. Newton Mobility Grants (RS, BA, RAEng)
- Costs for travel, subsistence and research expenses
- Awards last for up to two years
- Natural sciences including engineering, clinical or patient-oriented research, social sciences and humanities.
- Applications must have a Brazilian and UK coapplicant
- Closing date of applications from the British Academy and the Royal Society: 22nd October
- Closing date of applications from the Royal Academy of Engineering: 24th October













People – Fellowships for UK Researchers (SP State) New Fun

1. Young and Senior Fellowships

FAPESP's visiting researchers must be associated to a FAPESP PI (co-applicant) in charge of an ongoing grant of the following types: Thematic, Young Investigator, or Research, Innovation, and Diffusion of Knowledge Centers.

- **Scholarship:** ranging from R\$ 9,148.80 to R\$ 13,653.60.
- Travel support: airline ticket and health insurance.
- **Scholarship:** undergraduate student to assist the Researcher.
- Grant: The PI in charge of the grant to which the visitor will be associated may request from FAPESP supplementary funds of up to R\$ 25,000.00 for every six months of the visitor's stay. These funds are to be used for research related consumable materials, services, and travel.
- Post-doctoral scholarship: in case of visitors staying for 36 months.
- Applicants must have a UK based collaborator as their co-applicant.

2. Research Mobility

- Mission up one month: airline ticket, health insurance, and daily subsistence
- Mission from one month to three months: airline ticket, health insurance, and scholarship from R\$ 9,148.80 to R\$ 13,653.60.
- The FAPESP Visiting Researcher Grant is up to 12 months.
- Applicants must have a Brazilian based collaborator as their co-applicant.

Research - Research Partnerships



- Provide up to GBP 100 thousand for joint collaboration between UK and Brazilian researchers.
- Encourage applications that address the following areas:
- Health
- Urban transformations
- Food, energy, water, environment nexus -
- Biodiversity and ecosystems -
- Economic development and welfare reform
- Applications across all research areas will also be eligible, as long as they make a strong case for UK-Brazil collaboration and meet the eligibility ODA requirements.
- Deadline for submission is 17th October
- Successful grants will be announced in December 2014
