A Global First in Trans-Atlantic Research Funding Co-operation

Formed in October 2013, the Trans-Atlantic Platform (T-AP) is a collaboration between key humanities and social science funders in South America, North America and Europe

Never before have research funders in the Americas and Europe embarked on a collaboration of this scale!

T-AP Mission

The mission of the Trans-Atlantic Platform is to enhance the ability of funders, research organizations and researchers to engage in transnational dialogue and collaboration

T-AP Aims

- to **enhance** and **facilitate** high quality trans-Atlantic research networks and programmes related to Social Sciences and Humanities (SSH)
- to **promote** interdisciplinary SSH research on topics of medium and long-term interest
- to **share** and transfer knowledge and good practices

T-AP Members

- T-AP includes 17 major research funding organizations from South America, North America and Europe
- T-AP is a diverse platform bringing together humanities as well as social sciences funders
- Activities are open to non-T-AP members
- The full List of members is available on the T-AP website

T-AP Activities

- Offering joint calls for research in areas of strong potential for international collaboration
- Collaboration among funding organizations to align policies and practices facilitating international collaboration in the social sciences and humanities

T-AP Digging into Data Challenge

- In March 2016 T-AP launched the Digging into Data Challenge to support research projects that use “big data” to address questions in the social sciences and humanities
- Approximately \$9.2 Mio was awarded to **14 international teams** with members from at least three countries on both sides of the Atlantic

T-AP Social Innovation Call

- In October 2018, T-AP launched the second research call on Social Innovation
- The multi-national and trans-Atlantic projects funded under this call added value to our understandings of social innovation and deliver social innovation(s) through new research
- Approximately \$5.96 Mio was awarded to **ten international teams** with members from at least three countries on both sides of the Atlantic

T-AP RRR Call

- In April 2021, T-AP launched the third research call on Recovery, Renewal and Resilience in a Post-Pandemic World (RRR)
