
MAINSTREAM LITERATURE ON THE CONNECTION BETWEEN SOCIAL INCLUSION AND DEMOCRATIC INSTITUTIONS

- Increasing inequality and immigration flows in the US is associated with political polarization (McCarty et al 2016; Grechyna 2016)
- Left-wing parties in Europe favor “insiders” when their policy preferences diverge from “outsiders” (Rueda 2005)
- Parties adopt pro-rich policies when their preferences diverge from those advocated by middle class and the poor (Gilens 2012)
- In Northwest Europe, the pro-rich policy outcome applies for either left-wing or right-wing governments (Mathisen 2024)

NOT TRUE FOR LATIN AMERICA



Figure 1: Gini index (disposable income) and PP index in Latin America, 1990–2020




A POSITIVE CORRELATION BETWEEN PARTISAN or ELECTORAL POLARIZATION AND INEQUALITY REDUCTION

Brazilian case: subjective perception of gains and losses matters




Figure 2: Predicted Probability of Being a Petista, Antipetista or Nonpartisan given Status Change Perceptions




TRUST IN THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT IS PARTISAN, BUT..


DESPITE PARTISAN BIAS, TRUST AND APPROVAL OF THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT DECLINED

RESEARCH ON THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN INEQUALITY AND DEMOCRATIC BACKSLIDING CAN GREATLY BENEFIT FROM THE STUDY OF LATIN AMERICA CASES

- As in the US and Europe, political polarization is caused by the radicalization of right-wing parties (McCarty et al 2016)
- BUT, unlike Europe and USA
 - inequality reduction (Arretche 2018)
 - Inclusion of outsiders (Garay 2016)
 - Immigration is not a salient issue
 - Left-wing parties are associated with inequality reduction and the inclusion of outsiders
- What kind of voters' preferences is the far-right answering to?
- What are the sources and mechanisms behind the electoral success of right-wing parties?
